SAFETY RULES & GUIDELINES

Safety is our Priority.

Please understand the risks & take care. Wi: JUMP is an action sports facility where injuries can happen. Like all sports, participants need to decide if the benefits of involvement are worth the risk of injury. Jumping, rebounding using trampolines, slides and the obstacle course creates the risk for potential injury even when being safe. The potential for injury is greatly reduced when you:

- JUMP SAFE
- JUMP WITHIN YOUR SKILL LEVEL
- FOLLOW THE RULES
- WATCH OUT FOR OTHER JUMPERS

The whole point of Wi: JUMP is to have as much fun as possible jumping around. A critical part of this is a safe and soft landing and a safe environment to enjoy a real sense of freedom. Our rules and guidelines are designed to keep everyone safe and minimise the chance of injury.

Rules are shown below in 3 categories: General Safety Rules (apply to the whole centre), Area specific Safety Rules (Air Bag Safety Rules, Pro Zone Safety Rules, Basket Ball rules, Dodge ball game rules, Assault Course Safety Rules, Slides & Zip line Safety Rules) and finally Safety Rules pertaining Junior Jumpers. You will also find these rules displayed around Wi: JUMP. Please read them carefully and follow them.

1. GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- One person per trampoline
- Jump within your skill level
- Don't jump or land on the padding
- Wi: JUMP approved socks must be worn to ensure good grip.
- Don't attempt any activity beyond your skill level, Especially summersaults or backflips, if you attempt this understand that you do it at your own risk.
- Don't jump or land on padding.
- Watch out for other jumpers & always allow smaller jumpers right of way.
- Only one person on each trampoline at a time.
- Safely land on two feet or your bum when bouncing.
- No double bouncing, wrestling or rough play.
- No food or drink on or near the trampolines.
- No jumping when under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- No Running on staircases, walkways or the mezzanine chill areas
- No climbing-on, hanging over or leaning against any of the safety rails, balustrades or netting.

2. AREA SPECIFIC RULES

Airbag Safety Rules

- Never dive head first onto the airbag.
- No summersaults or backflips are permitted.
- Don't enter if others are in the way.
- Safely land on your bum or back.
- Spread your legs & bend your knees when entering the pit.
- Remove all items from pockets.
- Never land on your head or enter the big bag backwards.
- Exit as quickly as you can.

Pro zone

- Take extra care – trampolines in this area provide superior height & a greater degree of difficulty & risk.
- Jumpers must be over 125cm in height.
- Don't jump or land on the padding – it is there as a safety precaution.
- Don't attempt any activity beyond your skill level.
- Wi: JUMP Marshalls monitor safety strictly & their direction must be followed at all times

Running wall safety rules

- The Wall is for advanced jumpers only. Wi: JUMP Marshalls monitor the area strictly.

- Jumpers must be over 125cm in height.
- Only one jumper permitted on each wall trampoline at any time.
- Ensure no one is on the trampoline bed before jumping off the Running Wall.
- Only stand on top of the wall when you are actively using one of Running Wall trampolines.
- No climbing or scrambling up The Running Wall – if you can't run up develop your skills in other areas first.

Basketball Rules

- No hanging off the hoop, backboard or support bars.
- Stay on your track – don't jump across padding.
- No jumping or dunking from behind the backboard.
- Only one person on each trampoline at a time.
- Only attempt dunks within your skill level.

Assault Course

- Minimum 125cm height required for all participants
- One participant per obstacle at a time
- Only attempt obstacles within your skill level
- Watch out for other participants at all times to ensure adequate spacing
- Give way to faster runners
- Always use make use hand rails, supports and grips

Dodge ball Rules

- Max of 8 players per team on the large court (4 per team)
- Max of 6 players per team on the large court (3 per team)
- You may deflect a ball being thrown at you by using a ball in your hands.
- The court referee's call is final.
- Once out, exit and wait for the next game.
- Don't attempt flips or trick while playing a match.

"YOU'RE OUT" IF:

- You're hit by a live ball.
- You throw a live ball that's caught before it touches the ground or wall.
- "live" is a ball that has been thrown and not touched anything.
- You hit someone in the head.
- You cross or enter the neutral zone.
- You hold a ball for longer than 10 seconds.

Slide Rules

- One participant per slide at a time.
- Only go down the slides feet first.
- Wait your turn, no shoving, pushing or horseplay permitted
- Don't walk up the slides.
- Don't stand up on or run down the slides.
- Make sure the landing zone is clear before sliding

Zipline Safety Rules

- Always ensure a Marshal is present when using the Zipline
- Grip the handlebar firmly with both hands
- Ensure the recovery rope is behind you and not between your legs when launching
- Do not release your grip mid air.
- Always land feet first on the landing zone.
- Do not Land on your bum.
- Do not Land on your back.
- Do not Land on your knees.
- Exit the landing area as quick as possible.
- Only use the ladder to exit and do not walk up the zip line.

3. Wi: TODDLERS

Wi: JUMP has developed a Child and Youth Risk Management Strategy that is designed to help ensure this Wi: JUMP venue is a safe and supportive places for children and young people to attend.

Toddlers can access most areas of the park if being accompanied by a responsible jumping adult, but also have a dedicated section underneath the slides for jumpers under the age of 3.



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SAFETY FIRST

Wi: JUMP has a managed and monitored Safety Policy.

Wi: JUMP SAFE

The general safety rules and guidelines for each area are displayed throughout Wi: JUMP. Our terms and conditions outline the risks and anyone jumping at Wi: JUMP is deemed to have accepted these conditions prior to jumping.

Like most sporting activities, jumping on a trampoline creates the potential for injury even when done properly and following appropriate rules and guidelines. Our rules and safety guidelines have been developed in conjunction with recognised safety experts with the specific direction to meet or exceed international best practice. To minimise the chance of dangerous situations, especially for inexperienced Wi: Jumpers, we have clearly posted our court rules at the entrance to each court and at other activity zones throughout our facility. These rules are enforced by our Marshals.

Wi: JUMP TRAMPOLINES VS THE TRADITIONAL BACKYARD TRAMPOLINE

Historically, trampoline related injuries have occurred when jumpers have fallen off a trampoline onto the ground or landed on the frame. Wi: JUMP has minimized these risks by ensuring our trampoline areas and frames are covered in the highest-grade closed cell SPX33 padding. We have designed our facility to reduce or eliminate the hazards associated with typical home trampolines and are continually working to ensure a safe environment through optimal design, engineering, construction, training and research.

PADDING

Every square centimetre of exposed trampoline support structure (the steel and springs between the trampoline beds) is covered where possible by 50mm gymnastics-grade (SPX33) padding. The springs are completely encapsulated in a polypropylene sheet and covered by vinyl padding. We have exceeded the padding requirements advocated by the International leading standard.

STAFF & EXPERT SUPERVISION

Wi: JUMP trampoline courts / activity areas are monitored by highly trained and experienced staff. Our team of Wi: JUMP Marshals are trained in CPR and First Aid and are tasked with enforcing the court rules in a courteous manner. Our staff enforce our one person per trampoline rule to avoid collisions. Children under 110cm tall (which is generally those aged 6 years and under) are monitored continuously to ensure their safety at all times, and marshals take the utmost care to ensure these youngsters are kept safe away from the danger posed by older, more senior jumpers.

INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

Wi: JUMP has gone to great length to ensure international guidelines are adhered to in terms of best practice for trampoline safety. Wi: JUMP is working with Gymnastics Professionals to design the critical elements of our safety policies, programs and procedures. This has included the custom design of staff safety workshops and training programs.

TRAINING & INSTRUCTION

One of our primary safety principles is ensuring jumpers do not attempt any activity beyond their skills level. Classes will be available for all levels of ability to help develop skills from learning to jump safely through to specialised aerial training for action sports such as skiing, snowboarding, wakeboarding, kiteboarding, cross fit and gymnastics.

GRIP SOCKS

Anyone jumping at Wi: JUMP is required to wear our approved grip-socks at all times designed to help maximise grip, to help maximise safety and general hygiene.

Wi: JUNIOR JUMPERS

Jumpers 3 years and above can access most areas and have a dedicated section in the free jumping arena for their safety.

Wi: TODDLERS

Wi: JUMP has developed a Child and Youth Risk Management Strategy that is designed to help ensure this Wi: JUMP venue is a safe and supportive places for children and young people to attend. Toddlers can access most areas of the park if being accompanied by a responsible jumping adult, but also have a dedicated section underneath the slides for jumpers under the age of 3. A dedicated area for Wi: Toddlers is available & they are not permitted to jump on the main floor or zones. Full time parental supervision is required at all times.

FEEDBACK

BY SELECTING TO PURCHASING ANY TICKET "Wrist Band" IN A WI: JUMP VENUE OR VIA THE WI:

JUMP CONTACT CENTRE, WEBSITE OR BY ENTERING ANY WI: JUMP VENUE, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS CONDITIONS. IF YOU ARE MAKING A PURCHASE ON BEHALF OF ANOTHER PERSON, YOU AGREE THAT YOU ARE MAKING THE PURCHASE AS THEIR AGENT.

Wi: JUMP (Pty) Limited, trading as Wi: JUMP Carnival as the supplier of recreational services, sells all tickets and supplies all recreational services and facilities to you ("Customer") as well as to any other person you are making a booking on behalf of ("Participants") including, but not limited to trampolining, trampolining lessons, parkour, parkour lessons, use of the running wall, bag jump, volleyball, basketball courts, basketballs, assault course, slides, dodge ball court, dodgeballs, zip line, staircases, equipment rental and maintenance, the condition, layout, construction, design, maintenance and use of trampolines, the presence of people or objects thereon, the surrounding areas and any other associated sporting activities or similar leisure time pursuits (recreational activities) in the Wi: JUMP venue subject to the following conditions:

1.1. Wi: JUMP Carnival, Wi: JUMP (Pty) Limited, Wi: Eat, their employees, directors, agents, affiliates, parent companies and subsidiaries are not liable to the Customer and/or any Participant, your dependents or legal representatives for personal injury or death suffered by the Customer and/or Participant because the recreational activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose or because of the negligence, breach of contract, statute or statutory duty by Wi: JUMP .

1.2. The Customer acknowledges that the recreational activities are dangerous with many inherent risks and hazards and as a consequence personal injury and sometimes death can occur and the Customer assumes and accepts all such risks and hereby waives the right to sue Wi: JUMP for any personal injury or death in any way whatsoever caused by or relating to the Customer and/or the Participants participation in such activities.

1.3. RISK WARNING: The use of trampolines, parkour area, the running wall, bag jump, volleyball, basketball courts, basketballs, obstacle course, slides, dodge ball court, dodgeballs, zip line, staircases, ladders or any other equipment at any Wi: JUMP venue involves a significant risk of participants suffering personal injury including the possibility of serious injuries, permanent disability or death. All participants who engage in such recreational activities do so at their own risk.

1.4. The Customer agrees to pay the cost of and authorises Wi: JUMP to take all steps it considers reasonably necessary to protect his/her welfare as well as that of any Participant in the event of personal injury, including the administration of any emergency medical treatment and ambulance transportation.

1.5. Children must be at least 3 years of age to use the facilities at any Wi: JUMP venue and any minor children must be supervised by a responsible adult. Where you are responsible for such children you agree to be bound by these conditions on their behalf and you will directly supervise them at all times.

1.6. All participants must be in good health and free from any adverse medical conditions. For safety reasons, pregnant women, Customers and Participants with pre-existing health issues, pre-existing injuries, or wearing casts are not permitted on any equipment. If in doubt, please seek medical advice.

1.7. While in any Wi: JUMP venue you consent to images and video being taken for security or promotional purposes of yourself, your children or of children for whom you are responsible, without being entitled to any compensation therefor.

1.8. All tickets remain the property of Wi: JUMP and cannot be refunded, transferred or resold. They are valid only for the period of purchase and are void if tampered with.

1.9. The Customer and all Participants must comply with all signs or other directions of Wi: JUMP and it may suspend or cancel the Customer's and a Participant's access to recreational activities at any Wi: JUMP venue in its absolute discretion for non-compliance with these conditions, or for reckless or careless conduct.

1.10. If you purchase a ticket for the use of the trampolines, or any other equipment or facilities at any Wi: JUMP venue on behalf of another person, you and the other person both agree that you make that purchase as the authorised agent of that other person so that he/she will be bound by these conditions.

1.11. By purchasing a ticket the Customer and Participants hereby warrant that they are in good health and have no conditions that would prevent their participation at Wi: JUMP .

1.12. The Customer hereby warrants that any ticket purchased on behalf of any other person(s), including for parties and venue hires, is done so with the full consent and authority of every person for whom the Customer makes a booking. The Customer fully indemnifies Wi: JUMP and holds them harmless against any and all liability howsoever arising relating to every person on whose behalf the Customer has made a booking, including all legal costs and any damages awards.

1.13. In the event that a minor child is not accompanied by you and purchases a ticket to use any of the equipment or facilities at Wi: JUMP directly, it will be taken his/her "Parent" deemed to have consented to the minor child's purchase of a ticket and these terms and Conditions of sale shall be binding on such minor child. Should the Parent wish to prohibit the entry or further use of any of the Wi: JUMP facilities of such minor child to Wi: JUMP, he/she shall immediately contact Wi: JUMP and notify them of same, failing to do so the Parent shall be deemed to have consented to the minor child's purchase of a ticket and these terms and Conditions of sale shall be binding on such minor child.



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TRAMPOLINE LIABILITY WAIVER

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

What you are about to read is a waiver and release of liability. Upon entering any Wi:Jump Venue, you will give up your right to sue Wi: Jump (Pty) Ltd (the Party) , or anyone associated with above party such as its agents, owners, shareholders, directors, partners, employees, volunteers, manufacturers, participants, lessors, affiliates, its subsidiaries, related and affiliated entities, successors and assigns (the "Released Parties") for injuries or losses you suffer while using any facilities. In short, you cannot recover any money from it or the Released Parties if you are hurt while participating in activities at any of its facilities, including but not limited to those located at Wi: Jump, Mall@Carnival, Brakpan.

Please take your time and read this agreement very carefully. When you are certain that you understand and agree to each paragraph, you can enter the Wi:Jump Facility at your own risk.

"YOU" AND "I," AS USED HEREIN, INCLUDES THE PARTICIPANT AS WELL AS HIS OR HER HEIRS, EXECUTORS, DEPENDENTS, BENEFICIARIES AND ASSIGNS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO SPOUSES AND DOMESTIC PARTNERS. BY ENTERING OR WEARING THE WRISTBAND, YOU ARE AGREEING ON BEHALF OF THE ABOVE-LISTED PERSONS AND SHALL BE CONSIDERED BINDING UPON THEM.

YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITIES AT ABOVE LOCATION WITHOUT WEARING THE DESIGNATED WRISTBAND.

I UNDERSTAND THAT WEARING THE WRIST BAND OR ENTERING ANY WI:JUMP VENUE WILL PREVENT ME, MY HEIRS, EXECUTORS, DEPENDENTS, BENEFICIARIES, AND ASSIGNS FROM SUING ABOVE PARTY, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS OR GUESTS FOR ANY INJURIES, INCLUDING DEATH AND PARALYSIS, OR DAMAGES THAT I MIGHT RECEIVE WHILE PARTICIPATING IN ANY ACTIVITIES AT ABOVE LOCATION.

1. Trampoline use, gymnastics, and physical fitness training activities are dangerous and I ASSUME ALL RISKS, whether known or unknown, of injury, including death, illness or damage to my property.

I understand that there is a significant risk of serious physical injury, death and other damages inherent in trampoline use, gymnastics, and physical fitness training activities and in my use of THE PARTY facilities and instruction relating to these activities. These risks and hazards can include, but are not limited to, injuries arising from falling and striking objects or other people, including but not limited to paralysis resulting from striking objects; being struck by falling objects or people; failure of any part or all of the trampoline structures, flooring systems, building or training and fitness apparatus; defective, worn, uneven or separated trampoline equipment, flooring, or pads; failing to land on a trampoline bed or pad or landing on an unpadded structure, including falling between the springs of the trampoline bed; failure and/or breakage of trampolines or other equipment; strained or sprained muscles, joints and connective tissue; broken bones; personal injury including paralysis, death, illness, property damage, and other losses. Injury or death can arise from errors in judgment, from lack of training or information, from the negligence of me, employees or agents of THE PARTY or other parties, as well as the risks normally associated with athletic endeavors. There is no way to eliminate the risk of serious harm or death. I understand that my use of THE PARTY facilities and any instruction or knowledge I obtain at those facilities IS NOT sufficient to prepare me for all dangers and risks associated with trampoline use.

I CERTIFY THAT I UNDERSTAND TRAMPOLINE USE, GYMANSTICS, AND PHYSICAL FITNESS TRAINING ACTIVITIES, EXPOSE ME TO A HIGH RISK OF INJURY OR ACCIDENT. I KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL RISKS, WHETHER KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, OF PARALYSIS, INJURY, ILLNESS, DEATH OR DAMAGE OF WHATEVER KIND ARISING OUT OF MY PARTICIPATING IN ANY SUCH ACTIVITY AT THE PARTY FACILITIES OR SPONSORED BY ABOVE PARTY.

2. Release of liability, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK and hold harmless agreement is given in consideration for my participation.

I recognize that the above party could not offer this activity without obtaining a release of liability. In consideration of, and part payment for the right to use the above party's facilities, I RELEASE THE PARTY AND ANYONE ASSOCIATED WITH THE PARTY, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, STAFF, INSTRUCTORS, MEMBERS, AGENTS, GUESTS AND THIRD PARTIES AS WELL AS THE RELEASED PARTIES ENUMERATED ELSEWHERE IN THIS DOCUMENT, FROM ALL LIABILITY, AND KNOWINGLY, INTENTIONALLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVE ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS OR CAUSES OF ACTION OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLAIMS OF NEGLIGENCE, WHICH MAY ARISE AS A RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN A THE PARTY-SPONSORED ACTIVITY OR FROM USE OF THE PARTY FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT.

3. Covenant not to sue is given in consideration for my participation and use of the above party's facilities.

4. I will protect the above party from liability.

I AGREE TO DEFEND, PROTECT, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS THE PARTY, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, INSTRUCTORS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND GUESTS, AS WELL AS THE RELEASED PARTIES ENUMERATED ELSEWHERE IN THIS DOCUMENT, FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, SUITS, ACTIONS AT LAW OR IN EQUITY (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLAIMS OF NEGLIGENCE), FOR DAMAGES OR OTHER RELIEF AND AGAINST ANY LIABILITY OF ANY NATURE, TOGETHER WITH ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS INCURRED, THAT MAY ARISE OUT OF MY USE OF THE PARTY PROPERTY OR FACILITIES. I agree to pay THE PARTY's reasonable attorneys' fees and costs if I bring a suit for injuries suffered at a THE PARTY facility or through THE PARTY-related activities and that action is unsuccessful, in whole or in part.

5. I agree to abide by all THE PARTY rules INCLUDING THE PATRON CODE OF CONDUCT, ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED AS ATTACHMENT A.

I agree to abide by all THE PARTY rules contained in written form as well as verbal directions that may be given by THE PARTY staff or employees. I certify that I have read and agree to comply with my duties outlined in Attachment A.

6. I am physically qualified to participate.

I certify that I have no physical limitations or medical conditions that would impair my ability to fully and safely use THE PARTY facilities. I agree to inform THE PARTY of any conditions that may have any effect on my ability to fully and safely use THE PARTY facilities, so that a determination can be made as to the proper course of action.

7. Photo and media release.

By entering THE PARTY, I hereby grant THE PARTY on behalf of myself, and on behalf of my child(ren)/ward(s), the irrevocable right and permission to photograph and/or record me or my child(ren)/ward(s) in connection with THE PARTY and to use the photograph and/or recording for all purposes, including advertising and promotional purposes, in any manner and all media now or hereafter known, in perpetuity throughout the world, without restriction as to alteration. I waive any right to inspect or approve the use of the photograph and/or recording, and acknowledge and agree that the rights granted to this release are without compensation of any kind.

8. Other provisions.

This agreement constitutes the complete and sole agreement between me and THE PARTY, its officers, directors, instructors, employees, agents, members and guests and all others associated with THE PARTY. Evidence of any other agreements, whether oral or in writing, are void and inadmissible and unenforceable in a court of law, arbitration or other dispute resolution proceeding.

INDIVIDUAL OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, THE PARTY MEMBERS, INSTRUCTORS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS HAVE NO AUTHORITY OR POWER TO ALTER THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT, EITHER ORALLY OR IN WRITING. This agreement covers my use of THE PARTY facilities as well as my participation in all THE PARTY activities and all associated events.

9. Venue and Jurisdiction

THE LAWS OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA SHALL GOVERN THIS AGREEMENT. VENUE FOR ANY ACTION SHALL BE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF WI: JUMP/BRAKPAN.

10. Severability.

If for any reason a provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable, the offending provision may be amended to the extent necessary to conform to applicable law, or if it cannot be so amended without materially altering the intention of the Parties, it shall be severed here from. In either event, the remainder of the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

I AM FULLY AWARE OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS AGREEMENT AND RELEASE, AND HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL OF THE TERMS. THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT BIND ME, MY FAMILY (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO SPOUSES AND DOMESTIC PARTNERS), HEIRS, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, DEPENDENTS, BENEFICIARIES AND ASSIGNS. I recognize that if I have any questions regarding my waiver of rights, I should consult an attorney.

On behalf of myself and my spouse or domestic partner, I hereby KNOWINGLY, INTENTIONALLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVE AND RELEASE, indemnify, hold harmless and forever discharge THE PARTY, its officers, directors, instructors, employees, agents, members and guests and all others associated with THE PARTY of and from any and all claims, demands, debts, contracts, expenses, causes of action, lawsuits, damage and liabilities, of every kind and nature, whether known or unknown, in law or equity, that I, my spouse or domestic partner or said minor ever had or may have, arising from or in any way related to such minor's participation in activities in connection with THE PARTY. I further agree that I have full and sole responsibility for the safety and wellbeing of the above- named participant while he or she is using THE PARTY facilities or participating in THE PARTY- related events. I represent that I have sufficient insurance coverage to pay for any injuries suffered by the above-named participant and further represent that I have the ability and willingness to care for the abovenamed participant in the event he or she is injured or disabled. I further agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend THE PARTY, its officers, directors, instructors, employees, agents, members and guests and all others associated with THE PARTY from and against any claims (including but not limited to negligence), loss, damage, liability, expense, costs, and/or attorneys' fees, including those brought by or on behalf of, or otherwise caused by the above- named participant.

PATRON CODE OF CONDUCT

I understand there are inherent risks in the participation in or on any trampoline court. I understand I have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while using the trampoline court and to obey all oral or written warnings, or both, prior to or during participation, or both.

I understand I have a duty to not participate in or on any trampoline court when under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

I understand I have a duty to properly use all trampoline court safety equipment provided.

I understand I have a duty to not participate in or on any trampoline court if I have preexisting medical conditions, circulatory conditions, heart or lung conditions, recent surgeries, back or neck conditions, high blood pressure, any history of spine, musculoskeletal or head injury, or may be pregnant.

I understand I have a duty to remove inappropriate attire, including hard, sharp, or dangerous objects (such as buckles, pens, purses, badges, and so forth).

I understand I have a duty to avoid bodily contact with other patrons.

I understand I have a duty to conform with or meet height, weight, or age restrictions imposed by the manufacturer or owner to use or participate in the trampoline court activity.

I understand I have a duty to avoid crowding or overloading individual sections of the trampoline court and to refrain from "double-bouncing" other patrons.

I understand I have a duty to use the trampoline court within my own limitations, training and acquired skills.

I understand that summersaults or backflips are not permitted, and by attempting this I do it at my own risk.

I understand I have a duty to avoid landing on my head or neck. Serious injury, paralysis, or death, can occur.
